You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you select.

PAYMENT POLICY

Our funeral home, like many other businesses in our community, operates on a cash basis, being totally dependent upon prompt payment from the families we serve. Payment in full is expected at the time of arrangements or before the day of service unless otherwise indicated.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff \$1,300

This is the basic charge to each family which we serve for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of other taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also included in this charge is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, planning the funeral, and placement of obituary notices. There will be an additional charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains).

Embalming \$350

Embalming is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by this state must complete this procedure. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with extended viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Modified Preparation \$195

This service is for families who choose not to have embalming, but want to have a viewing. This charge includes sanitary care of human remains and setting of features. A person licensed by the state must complete this procedure.

OTHER CARE OF THE DECEASED

Identification Viewing \$295

This service provides families an opportunity to have a brief viewing of unembalmed human remains for identification or religious purposes up to but not to exceed 24 hours. This service includes modified preparation of the human remains, the placement in a casket/cremation container or on a table.

Non-Protective

These caskets are not designed by the manufacturer to resist the entrance of air, water or other outside elements. They may be constructed of metal, hardwood or wood products covered with fabric. A complete list of the caskets offered will be provided with this general price list.

FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

SHIP-OUT/NO LOCAL SERVICE **\$1,395**

This service includes: the basic services of staff and administrative staff and use of basic facilities; obtaining legal documents and other paperwork necessary to complete the transfer; transferring of the deceased from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; embalming and/or sanitary care of the remains.

Note: This service does not include: hair care; casket or air tray/combo container, visitation or viewing, service; service merchandise; automotive equipment, except as specifically set forth above; air tray, transportation on common carrier; cash advances; other funeral director charges; taxes or other additional services.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

SHIP-IN/CHAPEL OR CHURCH SERVICE (CASKETED REMAINS) **\$1,795**

This service includes: the services of funeral director and staff, administrative staff and professional staff for coordinating and directing the service; obtaining legal documents and other paperwork necessary to complete the arrangements, automotive equipment including to Portland Airport and casket coach to cemetery. Other municipal airports charge for mileage is \$2.50 per loaded mile. This service does not include: a limousine, other preparation of the remains, dressing, casketing, cosmetizing, casket, outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders, or acknowledgement cards and other cash advance items.

SHIP-IN/GRAVESIDE SERVICE (CASKETED REMAINS) **\$1,795**

This service includes: the services of funeral director and staff, administrative staff and professional staff for coordinating and directing the service; obtaining legal documents and other paperwork necessary to complete the arrangements, automotive equipment including to Portland Airport and casket coach to cemetery. Other municipal airports charge for mileage is \$2.50 per loaded mile. This service does not include: a limousine, other preparation of the remains, dressing, casketing, cosmetizing, casket, outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders or acknowledgement cards and other cash advance items.

SHIP-IN/DELIVERY TO LOCAL CEMETERY **\$1,095**

This includes professional services of staff in the coordination and supervision of all details in the care, planning and arrangement of final disposition, accommodating persons telephoning or visiting the funeral home, providing basic facilities and equipment; automotive equipment including to Portland Airport and casket coach to cemetery. Other municipal airports charge for mileage is \$2.50 per loaded mile. This service does not include: a limousine, embalming, other preparation of the remains, dressing, casketing, cosmetizing, casket, outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders or acknowledgement cards and other cash advance items, or visitation or funeral ceremony.

COMPLETE TRADITIONAL SERVICE AT OUR CHAPEL OR CHURCH **\$2,595**

This service includes: the services of funeral director and staff, administrative staff and professional staff for coordinating and directing the service; obtaining legal documents and other paperwork necessary to complete the arrangements; removal of the deceased (not including overtime charge) from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; embalming and/or sanitary care of the remains; other preparation of the remains, dressing, casketing, cosmetizing; use of the facilities for visitation up to two days; use of the facilities for the service or set up at the church or other facility and/or graveside; automotive equipment. This service does not include a limousine, casket, outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders or acknowledgement cards, and other cash advance items.

COMPLETE GRAVESIDE SERVICE

This service includes: the services of funeral director and staff, administrative staff and professional staff for coordinating and directing the service; obtaining legal documents and other paperwork necessary to complete the arrangements; removal of the deceased (not including overtime charges) from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; embalming and/or sanitary care of the remains; other preparation of the remains, dressing, casketing, cosmetizing; use of the facilities for visitation for up to two days; automotive equipment (funeral coach and utility vehicle). This service does not include a limousine, casket, outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders, or acknowledgement cards, and other cash advance

SCHEDULED IMMEDIATE BURIAL/ENTOMBMENT

This service includes: the basic services of funeral director and staff, administrative staff for obtaining and filing legal documents; removal of the deceased (not including overtime charges) from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; sanitary care of the remains; modified preparation; refrigeration equipment for holding remains for up to three days; transportation of the deceased to the cemetery for burial at a specific time scheduled through the funeral home by the family. This service does not include; embalming, viewing, use of facilities; funeral service; casket, outer burial container, burial charges, or other cash advance items.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL/ENTOMBMENT

This service includes: the basic services of the funeral director and administration staff for obtaining and filing legal documents; removal of the deceased (not including overtime charges) from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; sanitary care of the remains; modified preparation; use of facilities; refrigeration equipment for holding remains for up to three days; transportation of deceased to the cemetery at the discretion of the funeral home and/or the cemetery outer burial container for burial. This service does not include: embalming, viewing or use of facilities; funeral or graveside service; casket, burial charges or other cash advance items.

SERVICE OF REMEMBRANCE AT OUR CHAPEL OR CHURCH

\$1,440

This service includes: the services of funeral director and staff, administrative staff and professional staff for coordinating and directing the service; obtaining legal documents and other paperwork necessary to complete arrangements; removal of the deceased (not including overtime charges) from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; sanitary care of the remains; cremation charges, set up at the church or other facility and automotive equipment. This service does not include embalming, other preparation of the remains, dressing, casketing, cosmetizing, use of facilities for visitation; a limousine, cremation casket, permanent urn, outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders or acknowledgement cards and other cash advance items.

There is a \$50 fee from Cowlitz and King Counties for families who choose cremation. This charge is for extra investigation when the death occurs in their respective counties. This fee will be placed on the contract as a cash advance item.

CREMATION

\$845

This service includes: the basic services of the funeral director and administrative staff for obtaining and filing legal documents; removal of the deceased (not including overtime charges) from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; sanitary care of the remains; refrigeration equipment for holding remains up to 3 days; transportation of the deceased to the crematory, cremation process charge temporary (cardboard) urn. This service does not include: cremation casket; other preparation of remains, viewing or use of the facilities for viewing; funeral service; or cash advance items.

PACKAGES DO NOT INCLUDE ANY CASH ADVANCE ITEMS:

Sales tax, cemetery, death certificates, and permits; clergy or musician honorariums, air or other transport, out of town funeral homes, newspaper notices, escort services, hair care (female), etc.
